DIAGNOSTIC TESTING PROCESS

Suspect autism? The Applied Behavior Center for Autism offers in-house diagnostic evaluation and testing with shorter wait times. We have trained clinicians on staff to evaluate your child and determine whether they are on the autism spectrum. An autism diagnosis is required to receive authorization for ABA services.

AUTISM: NOW WHAT?

1. CONFIRM THE DIAGNOSIS

If you suspect your child may have autism, our team can schedule an evaluation with minimal wait times. Testing involves both virtual and in-person components. Already have a diagnosis? We can help confirm the results.

2. REMEMBER, YOU'RE NOT ALONE

3. SECURE INSURANCE/ MEDICAID COVERAGE

Our enrollment team handles all insurance processing on your behalf, free of charge. We'll advocate for you to find the best possible coverage options.

4. RECEIVE AN INITIAL EVALUATION

At our center, your child will complete an initial evaluation with a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). We'll assess your child's skills and create an individualized treatment plan with specific goals. You'll also have the chance to share your goals for your child and provide additional input.

5. START AND SEE RESULTS

Your child will begin ABA therapy based on the recommendations from our clinical team. A dedicated team of behavior therapists will work with your child, collecting data and adjusting the program as needed to ensure ongoing progress. Your behavior analyst will meet with you regularly to review progress, provide training, and offer support as your child works toward their goals.

CENTER-BASED ABA THERAPY
